This matter came before the Court on August 11 - 12, 2022 upon Plaintiffs' Verified Complaint for TRO, Preliminary, and Permanent Injunction filed on August 11, 2022. Defendants were given notice by the Plaintiffs, appeared, and were represented by attorneys Jennifer J. Dawson and Eli D. Boldt. Plaintiffs were represented by attorney Andrew R. Mayle. Both parties submitted written briefs.

The Court proceeded to hearing upon Plaintiff's application for a preliminary hearing. Testimony was offered by the parties. The parties also engaged in extensive negotiation to resolve this matter. Given the nature of the matter in controversy it is practically impossible for the Court to fashion a workable remedy in the sixty hours between the end of the hearing and the beginning of the school bus operating times for the first day of school on this Monday, August 15, 2022.

As an interim measure before the Court issues a decision, the Defendants are ordered to make best efforts to fashion a workable transportation plan that will treat both students of Sylvania Public Schools and students of Community Non-Public Schools located within the

geographic boundaries of the Sylvania City School District, similarly situated the same in regard to pick-up times for K-8 students. Specifically, the Defendants shall endeavor to create a plan that would pick-up K-8 students of Community Non-Public Schools located within the geographic boundaries of the Sylvania City School District on the same run as Sylvania Public Junior High School students. Defendants' transportation plan shall conform to all of the applicable requirements set forth in Chapter 3327 of the Ohio Revised Code.

It is therefore, ORDERED that Defendants submit their proposed transportation plan by August 26, 2022.
